

HAVE YOU EVER BEEN BULLIED?

Today, bullying is more prevalent than ever. Over 50 percent of adolescents and teens have been bullied online, according to the i-SAFE Foundation. And the results are devastating. In 2016 alone, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 5,400 bullycides, which is when a child commits suicide because they can't stand the bullying. In fact, bullycide is one of the leading causes of death in children under 14 years old.

If you were like many students and were bullied, you probably remember exactly how it feels. You probably remember your bully to this day. What if someone would have stood up for you? An upstander can literally mean the difference between life and death.

OUR STORY.

Bullying resulted in separate bomb threats in two consecutive years at the high school in Wisconsin that Linda Lee's children attended. At around the same time in late 2012, Linda came across this statistic: If a child sees bullying and intervenes in a nonthreatening way, the bullying stops in less than 10 seconds 85 percent of the time.

This became her guiding focus for founding Generations Against Bullying (GAB). While other organizations were focused on school administrators, faculty or parents, Linda founded GAB with a focus on empowering our children.

Linda designed each of GAB's resources to help children create a culture of upstanders through unique programs, education and services. She committed the organization to helping children, parents, schools, churches, law enforcement agencies and entire communities to better understand the bullying epidemic and how they can take a more active role in reshaping the culture in their hometowns.
